PERSONAL AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Content and Professional Will arrangements:

Maureen trained at Metanoia Institute, qualifying in 1999. She works as an integrative psychotherapist incorporating Eye Movement Desensitisation and Reprocessing (EMDR) into her practice. She is qualified and experienced in EMDR and in 2012 gained recognition by the EMDR Europe Association as an approved EMDR practitioner.

Maureen works as a counselling welfare officer for the Police Firearms Association. Her private practice is focused on working in depth with clients experiencing both developmental and environmental trauma. She described her clinical development as diverse and on-going.


She is a qualified and an experienced supervisor and has provided a minimum of 150 hours of monthly clinical supervision in the past 5 years to counselling practitioners. Supervision is on-going.

Therapist executor arrangements are in place with a professional colleague.

Verification:

Extensive and well documented CPD description – all verified – which fulfils the 250 hours of CPD required. This includes comprehensive specialised training in EMDR and attending workshops in NLP, EFT, self-hypnosis, trauma, conferences and others. Maureen also reads widely.

Supervision:	Monthly supervision on Skype for both EMDR and non-EMDR work. Maureen has individual as well as peer supervision with a colleague. Supervision hours logged and confirmed by both supervisors. An excellent reference was provided by Maureen's individual supervisor who described her as "a thorough and sensitive therapist", supporting her as an ethical and a rigorous practitioner. She stated that Maureen had dealt with a difficult court case in an ethical and professional manner.
Peer Review meeting:	Two peers and one non-familiar member who provided a signed summary of the meeting. Maureen provided a very thoughtful and reflective account of all aspects of her psychotherapy practice. The group fully supported Maureen's application recommending that she continues 'with this mode of identifying appropriate CPD'.
